### Luke 4 v14-22 and Romans 15 v1-6

<b>Welcome / Icebreaker</b>	What event / story / person changed your life? E.g. started you on a hobby or career
<b>Worship</b>	I’m glad I’m a Christian (YP82) / Invisible chains (YP257) / Jesus took my burdens / The Lord’s my shepherd (SoF537) / Living He loved me (YP30) / O happy day (YP265) / What a friend we have in Jesus (SoF593) / any song praising God for who He is or what He has done.
<b>Word</b> Luke 4 v17, 18, 21	What are the links between the Old Testament and the New Testament?
Luke 4 v18-19 Isaiah 61 v1-2	“Be free from” Are the freedoms that Jesus offers spiritual / physical / both?
Luke 4 v19 Isaiah 61 v2	What is the year of the Lord’s favour?
Romans 15 v1-3, 5-6	“Be free to” How should we use the freedoms given to us by Jesus? In what way are these verses related to the work of Jesus in Luke 4?
Romans 15 v4 2 Timothy 3 v16-17	How do the Scriptures encourage us and give us hope?
Ephesians 2 v8-9	What is the different between being free and being saved?
Ephesians 2 v10 2 Timothy 3 v16-17	We are saved by faith, not by good works; but we are expected to do good works. Discuss.
Luke 4 v17 Romans 15 v4 2 Timothy 3 v16 Psalm 119 v105	All of these passages are about learning from the Scriptures to give direction. How do we get our daily guidance from the Scriptures?
